

ABUSE AND DISRESPECT POLICY



At Sunny Town Learn and Play Childcare Centres we are committed to providing a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all children, staff, and families. To maintain this standard, we have established a zero-tolerance policy regarding abuse, raised voices and disrespect from parents or guardians towards our staff and other families.

POLICY STATEMENT

- 1. Zero Tolerance for Abuse and Disrespect:
 - Any form of verbal, physical, or emotional abuse or disrespectful behavior directed towards our staff, children, or other families will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- 2. Immediate Consequences:
 - In the event that a parent or guardian exhibits abusive or disrespectful behavior, Sunny Town Learn and Play Childcare Centres reserve the right to take immediate action. This may include:
 - Issuing a warning to the parent or guardian.
 - Requesting a meeting to address and resolve the issue.
 - In severe or repeated cases, the immediate termination of the child's enrollment at our center.
- 3. Procedure for Handling Incidents:
 - All incidents of abuse or disrespect will be documented by staff members and reported to the center's director.
 - The director will review the incident and determine the appropriate action based on the severity of the behavior and any previous incidents.
 - Parents or guardians involved in an incident will be notified promptly and given an opportunity to discuss the matter.
- 4. Appeal Process:
 - If a child's enrollment is terminated due to a parent or guardian's behavior, the parent or guardian may appeal the decision in writing within five business days.
 - The appeal will be reviewed by a committee comprised of senior staff members and an independent advisor, if necessary. The decision of the committee will be final.
- 5. Commitment to a Safe Environment:
 - We are dedicated to ensuring that Sunny Town Learn and Play Childcare Centres remain a positive and nurturing environment.
 - We encourage open communication and expect all parents, guardians, and staff to treat one another with respect and courtesy.
